This Thursday Wesley Park will host our monthly Feeding America Mobile Food Pantry. Any are welcome to come to stock up on fresh food. Our cost is \$625 a month which feeds hundreds of families as well as seniors at Pine Oak Senior Apartments. We want people to be able to eat healthy meals, to care for themselves and their families, and to make their income go further. I am so thankful for the love that goes into hosting this ministry by so many people each month. All volunteers are put to work anytime between 5 and 7 pm.

The IMPACT Worship and Service has been focusing on ways we can be extending hospitality to infants, children, youth, and adults. We want everyone to know they are welcome here, they are safe here, and they are loved here.

- ☀ We will offer Holy Communion to anyone who wants to receive beginning at 5 pm in the Sanctuary. All are welcome!
- ☀ We will collect diapers the first Sunday of each month and when we have enough we will set up an area just for families with infants to go on Food Truck Thursdays.
- ☀ We have sidewalk chalk for the kids to play with, and if there are people who can be in the playground, an area for the kids to play on the new play set.
- ☀ We want to learn kind things to say in both English and Spanish, and connect to people in authentic relationship.
