The United Methodist Church will gather in February of 2019 for a special called session of General Conference in order to consider proposals from the Commission on a Way Forward. These proposals reflect on ministry with LGBTQ persons and the ways the denomination will organize itself going forward.

Bishop Bard writes, "We United Methodists are asking what unity is possible, giving our significant differences on LGBT inclusion, rooted in differences in how we read our shared authoritative Scriptures, and our theological understandings. We United Methodists are asking what it might mean to bear with one another in love at this time in our history. As we struggle together, may we do so with humility, gentleness and patience."

Part of our fall/winter Wednesday Faith Formation series will be a time for Wesley Park to gather together in Holy Conversation. We will be reading and discussing the book Unity of the Church and Human Sexuality: Toward a Faithful United Methodist Witness, General Board of Higher Education and Ministry from January 16 through February 27, 2019, at Wesley Park. The time with Bishop Bard next Monday will help our conversations in January and February.
