Every four years the General Conference of The United Methodist Church gathers in worship and to do the work of choosing and organizing for our life together. Up to 1,000 delegates from around the world attend General Conference and consider thousands of petitions and amendments that become our Book of Discipline.

February 23-26, 2019 in St. Louis, Missouri, there will be a specially called General Conference focusing on the work of the Council of Bishop's Commission on a Way Forward. The 32-member Commission was authorized by General Conference 2016 and appointed by the Council of Bishops to examine paragraphs in The Book of Discipline concerning human sexuality and exploring options to strengthen the unity of the church. I invite you to a time of study and prayer at Wesley Park as we talk together from January 16-February 27, 2019. We will be using the book Unity of the Church and Human Sexuality: Toward a Faithful United Methodist Witness as our guide. I will be attending the Special General Conference as an observer.

The Wesley Park Church Conference will be Sunday, December 2 at 2 pm. Our District Superintendent, Rev. Margie Crawford, will be with us at Wesley Park where we will be hosting five other churches for their Church Conferences. We will be voting on a new way of administration at Wesley Park called the Governance Model. I will share with the congregation information about the Governance Model next Sunday between services with insight from churches that have adopted this model. Please let me know if you have questions. Let us keep the church in prayer.
