Radical Hospitality and Places to Serve

Over seventy people met together at 10 am on the first Sunday of January to learn more from the Vital Church Initiative "Away Team" about the VCI process. The focus was on one of the [Five Practices of a Fruitful Congregation](#), Radical Hospitality. Chuck Starnes encouraged all of us to be prayerful and ever mindful of the opportunities that are all around us to show radical hospitality to others. In particular, we were given time to imagine ways we could welcome people into Wesley Park UMC with grace and joy. At the end of the session people shared around the tables reflections on these two questions: "What is the one thing you can do to assure visitors and attendees of our Church feel welcome, important, and loved?" And, "What changes to our facilities and practices will make it easier for visitors to feel comfortable and find things easier?" The thoughtful responses were shared with the VCI team, who were excited about many common themes: name tags would help us know one another better; an information desk might help people find answers to their questions and increase the ease of entering a new church for the first time; and some work could be done to make the Welcome Center more welcoming, to name a few.

Already, work is being done around name tags for everyone who walks through the doors of Wesley Park for worship. And, ideas are being shared about what an information center might look like. And, some have begun to draw sketches of ways to open up the Welcome Center and create a coffee center and areas for conversation.
