Hail to the Lord's Anointed

Our focus for Advent is on the hymn *Hail to the Lord's Anointed*, written by James Montgomery (1771-1854). Professor of Sacred Music at Perkins School of Theology, Dr. C. Michael Hawn, in the History of Hymns for Discipleship Ministries shares his insight into Montgomery's life, and the source behind this hymn.

The United Methodist Hymnal contains six hymns by Montgomery, whose father was a minister. His parents later served as missionaries to the West Indies. James remained in Yorkshire and was raised from age 6 in a boy's boarding school administered by the Brethren of Fulneck. Montgomery later said, "There, whatever we did was done in the name and for the sake of Jesus Christ, whom we were taught to regard in the amiable and endearing light of a friend and brother." He began writing poetry at age 10, inspired by the hymns of the Moravians, the same group that inspired John and Charles Wesley. This hymn is a paraphrase of Psalm 72 written in 1821 for a Christmas leaflet, "Moravian Ode."

Psalm 72

Give the king thy judgements, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son. He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment. The mountains shall bring peace to the people, and the little hills, by righteousness. He shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor.

Montgomery edited the newspaper *Iris* for 31 years, during which he was a tireless supporter of social justice.

The verses of *Hail to the Lord's Anointed* help to prepare us for the One who ushers into the world Hope, Love, Joy, and Peace. May your Season of Advent be blessed!
