Happy New Year! Yes, that's right. The first Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of a new Christian year. The Christian calendar follows the story of Christ:

- ☀ Advent: Preparation for his coming birth.
- ☀ Christmas: Celebration of his entrance into the world.
- ☀ Epiphany: Recognition of his divinity.
- ☀ Lent: Preparation for his suffering, death, and resurrection.
- ☀ Easter: Celebration of his resurrection.
- ☀ Pentecost: Recognition of his eternal presence through the Holy Spirit.

The joy and wonder of faith in Christ is the ongoing opportunity we all have to begin again. Most people experience ups and downs in life. Challenges arise to disrupt and disengage some from a life of worship, study, prayer, and action. The burdens of life are at times overwhelming. But the seasons of preparation, celebration, and recognition continue to come around with constant "on-ramps" to rejoin the journey in ways you might not have been able to previously.
