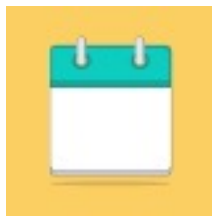

## Pastor's Page

"When we become hollow bones there is no limit to what the Higher Powers can do in and through us in spiritual things." – Attributed to Frank Fools Crow, Oglala Lakota Grandfather  
Shamans refer to our human bodies as "hollow bones" that conduct the breath of Spirit to heal what is torn in the fabric of our being by the nature of what it is to live and move in a world of form. Each of us comes into this world a physical vessel for Spirit. And from the moment each of us are born, Spirit moves through us in the form of music.

Deaf bioethics scholar Rachel Kolb wrote recently, "Music is about the body, about what happens when what we call sound escapes its vacuum and creates ripples in the world...it is wonderfully and inescapably visual, physical, tactile - and, in these ways, it weaves its rhythms through our lives." "Ruach," one Hebrew concept of Spirit, moves as voice and as breath through our bodies and the instruments we put our hands to, allowing Spirit to weave a new thing in our collective experience of the divine. When we call breath up over our vocal cords, when we strike or draw our hands over an instrument, when we hold a singing child in our lap or take our shoes off so we can feel the reverberation of a piano or an organ or a guitar, when we do this together and with intention, we call forth a Creator who answers us, joyfully, soulfully, wildly. As God moves through each of us, exactly as we are, we make with God a living thing that shimmers in our midst long after our singing and our playing have ceased.

In this season of Advent, of the earthy human and the luminous divine, of hard questions and adoring response, music brings enduring life, and light, and hope. May we receive these gifts, and many, and know how very beloved, and whole, we are. Amen.
