WORSHIP AT WESLEY PARK UNITED METHODIST CHURCH

REQUIRED FOR IN-PERSON WORSHIP:

- All 2-year olds and up must wear a mask over the mouth and nose. Bring a mask from home. Some masks are available if needed.
- Maintain 6-feet social distancing. Stay on the markers that designate safe distances.
- Bow or wave rather than hug or shake hands.
- Wash hands.
- Do not attend if you are feeling sick or have an elevated temperature.
- Use the Welcome Center entrance and remain in the designated disinfected areas of the church.

REGISTER FOR WORSHIP

- Go to www.wesleypark.org/worship and register each week.
- Or, call 616-988-6738 and choose option 2. Leave your name, number of people you are registering, and your phone number.
- If we are under-capacity people can still attend worship after checking in with the attendance volunteer.
- If we are at-capacity, people who did not register will be invited to tune into worship from the parking lot radio broadcast.

WORSHIP OPTIONS:

- Register to attend in-person worship at 10 am each Sunday, following all of the safety guidelines.
- 107.7 will broadcast the worship service to car radios in our parking lot during the in-person worship. If wearing a mask is difficult, the FLC is at capacity, or you choose to be more cautious, the radio might be a good option. Please wear a mask and maintain safe distancing if you exit your vehicle.
- The 10 am service will be live streamed. You can find the link on our website at www.wesleypark.org/live-stream.
- Pre-recorded worship will be streamed at 6 pm each Sunday night for any who would like to watch worship together from home. You can find the link on our website at www.wesleypark.org/live-stream.

HELPFUL HINTS:

- Arrive early. The check-in process takes a few minutes.
- Bring your check-in questions from mailing #4 to affirm the questions for the health check-in process.
- Be patient and kind. We are all learning how to do worship in this new way.
- Restrooms will be open but we are encouraged to use them only in case of emergency.
- Please do not bring water or coffee into the church.
- Move from inside to outside to visit. Remember to maintain proper social distancing and wear masks outside.
- The offering will be collected at the end of worship as we leave the Family Life Center, or you can give online (www.wesleypark.org) or by text message (616-213-0707). If you are in your car turn on your lights and an usher will come and collect your offering.
